



## **Standard Notice Under the No Surprises Act**

The purpose of this notice is to inform consumers of the No Surprise Act under section 27988B-2(d) of the Public Health Service Act (PHS Act) and how consumers are protected from unexpected medical bills related to out-of-network service providers.

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) developed standard notice and consent documents under section 2799B-2(d) of the Public Health Service Act (PHS Act). This notice and consent documents are required when an out-of-network provider provides services to participants, beneficiaries, enrollees, or covered individuals in group health plans or group or individual health insurance coverage, including Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) plans by either:

- A nonparticipating provider or nonparticipating emergency facility when furnishing certain post-stabilization services, or
- A nonparticipating provider (or facility on behalf of the provider) when furnishing non-emergency services (other than ancillary services) at certain participating health care facilities.
